On Thursday 4/14/11 at approximately 6:30 PM Bristol Police responded to the Ricotti Sandwich Shop at 11 Gooding Avenue for a past assault. According to witness accounts two males, a 19 year old male victim from Metacom Avenue Bristol, and a 14 year old male entered the restaurant and sat down. The two were followed by a male know by the victim to be Lyndon B. Ferioli age 20 of 28 Broad Street Warren RI. Ferioli allegedly grabbed the 19 year old male while holding a butterfly knife causing a puncture wound to the victim's right shoulder and lacerations to the victim's left hand. Ferioli fled in a Black colored Chevrolet Camaro. The victim was transported to RI Hospital for treatment and was later released. At 9:21 PM Ferioli responded to the Bristol Police Department where he was booked on one count of felony assault and disorderly conduct. Ferioli was brought to the Sixth Division District Court in Providence on 04-15-11 where bail was set at \$10,000 with surety. It was learned that Ferioli and the victim were known to each other and had an ongoing dispute regarding stolen property.
