On Thursday May 5, 2011 at approximately 7:50 AM Bristol Police were dispatched to the Roger Williams University Recreation Center for a bomb threat. During the investigation it was learned that Abdulrahman Khalid Althuwayb age 25 of 286 Wood Street Bristol RI made a threatening statement to a RWU Dining Services Supervisor. Althuwayb was reported to have requested food service before the center was open. The worker served Althuwayb and asked him to come tomorrow when the service is open. The Supervisor and a second school employee both reported that Althuwayb replied, "'OK don't worry today is the last day, & tomorrow I blow the walls out".

Althuwayb was taken into custody at the RWU Campus and brought to the Bristol RI Police Department. Althuwayb was charged with RIGL 11-35-18 Bomb Threats and Similar False Reports. He was arraigned on Thursday May 5, 2011 in the Sixth Division District Court in Providence RI and held on \$10,000.00 with surety bail. Althuwayb is enrolled in the ELS Learning Center Program and attends courses at Roger Williams University. Althuwayb is a citizen of Saudi Arabia, US Immigration and Customs Enforcement set a Detainer for Althuwayb.
